HAYMARKET SENATORS PARTNER WITH LOCAL MEDICAL TEAM

Dr. Holly Moriarty focuses on keeping college baseball players healthy during summer wooden bat season.

Haymarket, VA—June 2, 2011—Play Ball, Haymarket! College level baseball is back with the return of the Haymarket Senators. One of 12 teams in the summer wooden bat Valley Baseball League, sponsored in part by Major League Baseball, the Haymarket Senators feature leading college players from across the country. To keep players healthy during the 44 game season, the Senators have forged a partnership with area sports medicine professionals. Whenever the Senators take the field in June and July, supporting them in the dugout is a local athletic training staff from Haymarket Physical Therapy & Chiropractic (HPTC).

Recognizing her knowledge of sports medicine and on-going work with athletes of all levels, the partnership with Dr. Moriarty was a natural fit. The team's community connection continues beyond medical care. Not only are all home games played at The Haymarket Senators play their home games at Battlefield High School in Haymarket, VA. In turn, this not-for-profit organization actively supports the community. "All money brought in goes to either running the Haymarket Senators or to various little leagues and other youth sports in Prince William and Loudoun Counties that the Senators sponsor as part of our charter," explains Schaffler.
